

Women are at the center of every narrative; not necessarily well-known athletes as much as those who, through different or lesser-known sports, find the strength to challenge conventions, to question their own existence and to look inward as a means to look beyond. From South Africa to Bangladesh, from Canada to Nepal, from Europe to Afghanistan, a changing wave of cinematographic endorphins that does not pass without leaving a mark ... because, in each of these stories, we also find a little bit of ourselves.

With more than just the championship on the line, the girls fight to blaze a new path for the next generation of Native women, while still honoring their people's tradition in a changing world.
